
Howe Performance Raptor Kit Instructions

- **1.** Remove all the stock Ford Steering components including pump, hoses, and reservoir. (Set aside, some parts will be needed)
- 2. Insert supplied black plugs into stock power steering cooler. The cooler will remain in its location. Plugs are supplied to prevent fluid dripping out over time.
- **3.** Remove roll dowels from the stock Ford Raptor power steering pump and insert into the bottom side of the new bracket. (See picture)



- **4.** Install pump bracket onto motor. Once installed, you can mount the TC pump to the bracket.
- **5.** Install the reservoir bracket onto main core support in front of radiator. You will have to drill out two 5/16" holes for the bracket to through-bolt to.



- 6. Down on the rack, install the supplied port block with welded AN Fittings. Use Blue Loc-Tite to help secure bolt to rack.(This will require a 6mm size allen wrench to tighten supplied bolt into rack) The larger fitting (-8) will be the return line to the cooler on the reservoir. The smaller (-6 High Pressure) fitting will be the hose to the T/C pump. Hold port block with 7/8" Wrench while tightening fittings onto port block.
- **7.** Put together hoses with fittings. You will have to align the fittings to have the needed angle. (See Hose assembly instructions)
- **8.** Install hoses according to hose diagram
- **9.** Fill the filter full of power steering fluid and screw onto bottom of reservoir hand tight. Then add fluid to reservoir and fill the system full of supplied fluid.
- 10. Follow the bleeding instructions

The Howe Performance Raptor Power Steering Kit is intended to be installed by professional installers only. Some tools will be required to complete the installation
